The Digital Divide

- Something we wanna bridge
- Division in access to digital technology, services etc.
- ICT = A tool
 - ...to gain knowledge => Knowledge Divide
- **ICT4D** (ICT = Information and Communication Technology, 4D = For Development)

Education: The digital divide


- Most people don't have an Internet connection
- Estimates
 - Around 40% of the world population has an Internet connection today (http://www.internetlivestats.com)
- Access to education increasingly becomes a question of access to ICT (and Internet!)

Measuring Internet connectivity

- SA, 2017: "There are about 29-million smartphones in use in South Africa but only 21-million Internet users [~40% of population], which tells us a quarter of the smartphone user base cannot afford data"
 - Of the 21-million total, 7-million use only mobile. The rest have [additional] access at work or use WiFi hotspots
- Can you stream?
- 1 school subscriber providing access to 1000 students for education?

On or off?

Need for offline O bandwidth ←------ Really fast

> Available? Affordable? Stable?

Zero-rating

- Providing some services for free
- Net neutrality :(
- Rejected by India
- Zero-rating did not bring most mobile Internet users online for the first time. Nearly nine in 10 users surveyed report having used the Internet before accessing it through a zero-rated plan.





Sneakernet

- The idea that data is carried by foot (sneakers)
- Not fiction!
 - CDRs, USBs
- Has an enormous bandwidth
- Technological enablers
 - increasingly cheap storage media



 - Student accounts
 - Teacher accounts

- Still alive and well supported

Kolibri

- Successor of KA Lite, which does more than Khan Academy
- Concept of 'channels'
 - Online content curation (creation of channels)
- Built by Learning Equality
 - Supported by a range of orgs: UNICEF, Google.org
- Public launch fall 2017



...and more

- Ubuntu/Debian repositories offline through normal mirror services
- Making your own offline Intranet
- NFS, Samba shares w/ videos, ebooks
- Bring ISO images!
- Bring documentation!



Bringing it all together

- Server + LAN
- WIFI vs. ethernet

- (Really nice) to have: Projector, printer
- "Internet ready"

- Censorship
 - VPN
 - Tor
 - Proxies
- Shutdowns
 - Offline

Censorship and shutdowns

- Countries building censorship into the infrastructure
 - Blocking Internet access (social media) during elections
 - Easier to turn the big switch!
- Recently
 - Turkey blocks Wikipedia (2017) (@TurkeyBlocks on Twitter)
 - Cameroon English speaking province (93 days #KeepItOn 2017)
 - Unrests in Ethiopia (2016-2017)
 - Iraq national exams 2015, 2016, 2017
- Technological advances
 - Russia Bans 'Uncensored' VPNs, Proxies and Tor



- 3. And, whereas, to thwart the designs and activities of anti-national and anti-social groups/elements and maintain peace and communal harmony in the border State of Haryana, and to prevent any loss of life or damage to public/private property, it has become necessary to take all necessary steps and measures to maintain Law and Order in the State of Haryana in public interest, by stopping the spread of disinformation and false rumours, through various social media platforms, such as Whatsapp, Facebook, Twitter, etc. on mobile phones and SMS, for facilitating and/or mobilization of mobs of agitators and demonstrators, who can cause serious loss of life and/or damage to public/private property by indulging in arson/vandalism and other types of violent activities.
- Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred upon me by virtue of Rule 2 of Temporary Suspension of Telecom Services (Public Emergency or Public Safety) Rules, 2017, I Home Secretary, Haryana do hereby order suspension of the (i) Mobile internet services (2G/3G/4G/CDMA/GPRS), (ii) all SMS services and [iii] all dongle services etc. provided on mobile networks except voice calls in the territorial jurisdiction of State of Haryana. Haryana Telecom Services providers and Head of BSNL (Haryana jurisdiction) are hereby directed to ensure compliance of this order.
- 5. This order is issued to prevent any disturbance of peace and public order in the jurisdiction of State of Haryana and shall be in force for the next three days, from the time this suspension order becomes operational.
- 6. This order is being passed ex-parte in view of the emergent situation. It shall be published for the information of public through press and means of communication.
- Any person found guilty for violation of aforesaid order. will be liable for legal action.

It's hard to censor offline data.

- 1. Be offline friendly
 - 2. Be Offline first

Making data available offline

- Mediawiki is a good platform because of Kiwix scraping compatibility
- Building a self-containable open source HTTP server application (Django etc)
- At the very least: Don't put obstacles for others...

Don't do

- Weird licenses
- DRM
- Challenge `wget --recursive`
 - Single-page websites/apps
 - If you have no offline strategy or services, at least don't block scrapers



Application performance: Offline First

- Offline First
 - We live in a disconnected & battery powered world, but our technology and best practices are a leftover from the always connected & steadily powered past. Offlinefirst.org
- Store user data locally = offline friendly
- Store ALL data locally = offline first

Too much online dependency?

- User pays for data
- Slow responsiveness
 - Always up to date = always fetching data

Offline first

- Obvious places where you have "first-world problem" connectivity issues:
 - Subway
 - Airlines
 - High-speed trains
 - In the woods
 - Big events

Offline first

- Frequently not having any data connection <u>in</u>
 even the wealthiest and most developed cities
 of the world has led us to conclude that no,
 the mobile connectivity/bandwidth issue <u>isn't</u>
 just going to solve itself on a global level
 anywhere in the near future.
- »Our carefully constructed app experiences become sources of frustration« Alex Feyerke (hood.ie)

Benefits

- UX: Faster
- Productive despite connectivity issues
- Simplifies design/architecture
 - Caching problems
 - No offline+online UI design
 - No push/pull error messages

Cloud vs. localhost

- Fonts
- Embeds and iframes
